1. Mission, Values, and Equity

- ☐ Does this AI use case support our mission and social impact goals?
- ☐ Have we evaluated its potential impact on equity and inclusion?
- ☐ Were community members or stakeholders consulted in this decision?

2. Data Use and Privacy

- ☐ Is data collected ethically and with consent?
- ☐ Are personal and sensitive data protected?
- ☐ Do our practices comply with legal and governance standards?

3. Bias, Fairness, and Accessibility

- ☐ Has the system been evaluated for bias or systemic inequity?
- ☐ Is it accessible to staff with varying technical skills?
- ☐ Does it consider diverse needs and reduce harm?

4. Transparency and Human Oversight

- ☐ Can we clearly explain how the AI system works and its limitations?
- ☐ Are humans involved in high-stakes decisions?

- ☐ Can staff challenge or override AI outputs?

5. Risk and Accountability

- ☐ Have we identified potential harms or misuse scenarios?
- ☐ Is there a mitigation plan in case of errors or harm?
- ☐ Are oversight responsibilities clearly assigned?

6. Training, Monitoring, and Feedback

- ☐ Have we trained staff to use AI tools responsibly?
- ☐ Is there a plan to monitor, audit, and update the AI use regularly?
- ☐ Do we collect and act on feedback from staff and stakeholders?

7. Trust and Sector Contribution

- ☐ Are we transparent about AI use with the public and partners?
- ☐ Could our use strengthen or weaken trust?
- ☐ Are we contributing learnings back to the field?
